The office space for the MSC located at 777 North Capitol Street has been secured (Suites 401 and 402) and work has commenced on the following items:

- Carpet and paint selection
- Development of an RFP for office space design and furniture lease
 - COG staff is also investigating the use of a Cooperative Purchasing program vendor through a competitive bid conducted through the Mid Atlantic Purchasing Team (MAPT) partnership under a Howard County contract. This may allow COG to obtain MSC office space design services along with the option to buy furniture at a deeply discounted rate based on contract prices or perhaps lease the furniture.
 - Another option being investigated is the use of surplus furniture either through the federal government or though other building tenants (including COG) that are currently remodeling their respective office spaces.

It is anticipated that a decision will be made on this over the course of the next week or so in order that the office space is suitable for MSC employee use by late May to early June 2018.
