The Metrorail Safety Commission has secured the domain WMSC.GOV and setup temporary email and server hosting. We are hoping to migrate this to the Microsoft O365 Gov Cloud offering as soon as we can jump through their qualification hoops.

The website contents has been transferred to a new server but was built on an old platform and some of the pages are not displaying. We have brought in a specialist to look at the issue and working on a resolution.
