RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE CONTRIBUTION AND EFFORTS
MADE BY CERTAIN ENTITIES IN ESTABLISHING THE WMSC

WHEREAS, in 2017, Congress passed and the president signed into law legislation authorizing the formation of the Washington Metrorail Safety Commission (“WMSC”) (also known P.L. 115-54 or the “Compact”);

WHEREAS, the Compact was the product of many years of work, dedication and effort by the Federal Transit Administration (the “FTA”), the District of Columbia, Commonwealth of Virginia and State of Maryland (collectively, “the Jurisdictions”), and the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (the “MWCOC”), among other stakeholders;

WHEREAS, since enactment of the Compact, additional and substantial work, dedication and effort by the FTA, the Jurisdictions and MWCOC have been necessary to establish the WMSC and provide it with the financial, legal, operational, administrative and technical support necessary to carry out its mission and succeed as an independent organization; and

WHEREAS, the MWCOC has played a unique and notable role in incubating and establishing the WMSC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE WASHINGTON METRORAIL SAFETY COMMISSION:

Recognizes the work, dedication and effort by the FTA, the District of Columbia, Commonwealth of Virginia, State of Maryland, and MWCOC in establishing the WMSC.
