Executive Summary

On October 14, 2018, at approximately 23:50 hrs., an eight (8) car Non-Revenue consist L7404-05x7412-13x7328-29x7356-57T within Greenbelt Yard was instructed by the Greenbelt Tower Interlocking Operator (I/O) to lay up/store on Yard Track 8. After receiving a lead to Yard Track 8, the train made contact with a Rail Tie and Geismar Torque Wrench which were improperly stored and fouling Track 8 during prior maintenance activity on Track 7. As a result, damages to the Collector Shoe Assembly on car 7404 and to the Air Spring Cut-Out Valve on car 7412 were identified.

The Train Operator (T/O) and the Interlocking Operator (I/O) were removed from service for post incident analysis and a subsequent incident interview with SAFE. Additionally, the train consist was removed from service for post incident analysis and an inspection was performed by Vehicle Program Services (CENV) and Car Maintenance (CMNT) respectively.

No other damage or injuries were reported as a result of this incident.

Investigation

On October 14, 2018, at approximately 23:50 hrs., the T/O on Non-Revenue consist L7404-05x7412-13x7328-29x7356-57T was instructed by the Greenbelt Tower I/O to store train on Yard Track 8. After receiving a lead to yard Track 8, the train made contact with a rail tie and a Geismar Torque Wrench which were improperly stored during a prior maintenance activity on Track 7 and were fouling Track 8. The T/O reported stopping the train after hearing a loud bang. The T/O notified the I/O that the train was unable to clear the track and the T/O requested to reverse ends and store the consist on another track. As a result of this minor collision with the fixed object, the train sustained damage to the Collector Shoe Assembly on car 7404 and damage to the Air Spring Cut-Out Valve on car 7412.

Office of Transportation (RTRA)

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Interlocking Operator

Per I/O Written Statement, "The T/O was laying Train ID 591 on Track 8. He had a collision with a tie remover unit that was on Track 7. The tie remover damaged car 7507 right side collector shoe assembly. I saw the T/O stop and I asked him if he was okay. The T/O said he needed to reverse ends. The communication was bad, so I gave permission to clear 92 and send him on Track 14 and then I asked the T/O to give me a landline. Once the T/O told me what happened I contacted the shop, ROCC and the office. The T/O never stated he came in contact with anything until he called me."

CMNT

Inspection was conducted by CMNT personnel to Rail Car 7404 and 7412 where damage was located. See Attachment 1 and 2.

Weather

At the time of the incident, the temperature was 57°F, and clear. SAFE has concluded that weather was not a contributing factor in this incident (Weather source: National Oceanic Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) - Location: Washington, DC.)

Findings

- TRST Supervisor was the Roadway Worker in Charge (RWIC) of the work area.
- TRST work crew was assigned to perform tie renewal, on Track 7 in Greenbelt Yard.
- On 10/14/2018 at 14:16 hrs., TRST Supervisor contacted Greenbelt Tower vis radio, clearing Track 7 and 8. TRST Supervisor also responded to the Tower station that, Track 8 is clear for train movement."
- Maintenance equipment was improperly stored
- I/O is a 12-year WMATA employee
- I/O has been Rail Operations for 10 years
- I/O did not have any recent safety violations

Immediate Mitigation

1. Train Consist was removed from service

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- 2. Train Operator was sent for post incident testing
- 3. Interlocking Operator was sent for post incident testing
- 4. TRST Supervisor and the Interlocking Operator were counseled and re-instructed.

Conclusion

Based on the salient facts, SAFE has concluded that the incident was a result of human error. TRST Supervisor and crew worked on Track 7 prior to the accident on Track 8. The TRST Supervisor gave up both tracks and confirmed via radio with the Greenbelt Tower that Track 8 was clear for train movement. However, the TRST Supervisor failed to perform a thorough track inspection before relinquishing the work area. The improper storage and housekeeping of maintenance equipment on Track 7 was a contributing factor of this incident.

The I/O was notified by the T/O that Track 8 could not be cleared, and that the T/O needed to reserve ends. The I/O did not stop all movement in that section of the yard where the collision occurred. The I/O failed to personally investigate the incident that occurred in the yard. In addition, the I/O moved the incident train prior to investigating that it was safe to move the incident train.

Considering all the facts gathered from this investigation, SAFE has no further concerns regarding this incident and recommends E18442 for closure.

Corrective Action

No further corrective action taken as part of this event.
