Description	ROW under revenue service, using Foul Time, AMF and Watchmen Lookout.  No other crafts were piggybacking with this work crew.  Inspection Location: A04 – Woodley Park - 2700 Connecticut Ave, NW,  Washington, DC 20008, walking to Cleveland Park – Red Line.  With the permission requested and granted by the OPS-1, Red Line Controller, the inspection commenced at approximately 10:00 (am).  Notable Observations:  ✓ All employees wore the appropriate WMATA company issued PPE in and about the tracks  ✓ No defects with respect to ATC equipment  ✓ 3 - items to note; (1) busted water pipe attached to wall flowing down to Impedance bond MCM cabling at J-bar, copper T-bar. (2) there is a grate near the Cleveland Park Station, that has water gushing up from it. The water flows down the incline, in a West direction. You can hear the water rushing downhill; which sounds like a rushing brook or stream. (3) there is old cut rail on the ROW. This is a tripping hazard to MOW crew members. It must be removed to avoid employees tripping over it.  ✓ Employees exhibited great radio communication; Roadway Workers to Ops 1 Controller.	Recommended Reinspection?	YES					
Remedial Action	WMATA Engineering is looking into a solution of a sealant to stop the intrusion of the water from coming through the walls. From what I am made to understand; this is a long-time on-going issue that WMATA is taking steps toward mitigating.  Will schedule follow-up for re-inspection to assure that the pipe on the wall is repaired to stop the water from gushing onto the walkway (causing premature rusting of walkway) down to the track.							
	Will schedule follow-up to re-inspect for removal of old rail on ROW in tunnel.
