Description	To verify that ATCM tools (not to include radios) are calibrated in a timely matter. Assuring that inventory is serviceable, and available according to the TOC's 2015 triennial review report. Also assuring that ATCM and Production continue an ongoing effort to eliminate unused equipment from inventory. Findings: Areas for Improvement still needed by MAXIMO, SAMS Group, and ATCM: During recent inspections, I found that the ATC Department still falls short in maintaining up-to-date documentation for equipment in their possession at various shops and TCR facilities. ATCM, MAXIMO, and SAMs Group now actively participating in coordinating for the accurate up-to-dating of documentation of assets. Reinspection scheduled for February 2021 for compliance. Giving the departments an opportunity to perform a system wide inspection of ATCM assets and to update all departments involved for better record up keep. Review of this document informs me that QICO is monitoring the performance of the interdepartmental participation as well.	Recommended Reinspection?	YES
