

for the first three-quarters of the calendar year were cancelled due to ongoing COVID-19 response operations. The skill stations organized for participants were set up to allow for social distancing while providing real-world hands-on experience. Mask and social distancing were required for the duration of the exercise. Prior to beginning, emergency plans, procedures and protocols were reviewed.

The four training stations were:

- 1. Incident Command
- 2. ETEC Deployment
- 3. Hot Stick and WSAD (warning strobe alarm device) training
- 4. 7000 Series Train Familiarization

Set up began at 0500hrs with Metrorail preparing the work area followed by a safety briefing and registration. The exercise concluded at 1200hrs with an evaluation, debrief and Hot Wash.

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
