Prohibited use of cell phones includes text messaging, conversations, or using any of the phone applications (calendar, camera, etc.).		
	Safety Rule 4.227 (b) While operating Class I or II vehicles, cell phones and electronic devices are to be turned off and stored offperson. In the event of a life-threatening situation or an Authority provided radio malfunction, cellular phones may be used to contact Central Control after the vehicle is stopped in a safe place.
