

THE WASHINGTON METRORAIL SAFETY COMMISSION
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR STATE
SAFETY OVERSIGHT AGENCY SUPPORT SERVICES

WHEREAS, Sec. 24 of the Washington Metrorail Safety Commission (WMSC) Interstate Compact (P.L. 115-54) required the Board to adopt a procurement policy;

WHEREAS, the WMSC adopted a Procurement Manual on December 10, 2019, that describes the methods and procedures that the WMSC uses to procure goods or services;

WHEREAS, the Procurement Manual specifies that “[n]o procurement may be awarded involving an annual expenditure of more than \$50,000, unless it has been approved by the Commissioners,” and requires that a request for proposals (RFP) be issued when the total anticipated purchase price of any good or service is anticipated to exceed \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, the WMSC now plans to issue an RFP for services that is anticipated to exceed the \$250,000 threshold.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE WASHINGTON METRORAIL SAFETY COMMISSION:

Authorizes the WMSC to make an award at the conclusion of a competitive solicitation for the following procurement action in accordance with the WMSC Procurement Manual:
