

THE WASHINGTON METRORAIL SAFETY COMMISSION

RESOLUTION MAKING INTERIM CHANGE TO THE PROGRAM STANDARD

WHEREAS, Sec. 3(b) of the Washington Metrorail Safety Commission (“WMSC”) Compact (P.L. 115-54) requires the WMSC to “[d]evelop and adopt a written state safety oversight program standard”;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sec. 2.C. of the Program Standard, effective June 28, 2021, the WMSC may make interim changes to it; and

WHEREAS, the WMSC has determined a need for clarity regarding the receipt of Temporary Use Notices from WMATA, as described in Section 10.A.2.; and

WHEREAS, the WMSC believes that resolving this ambiguity is a time-critical task so that the WMSC may effectively and properly carry out its mandate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE WASHINGTON METRORAIL SAFETY COMMISSION:

Adopts the attached interim change to the Program Standard and approves its transmittal to the designated WMATA contact person, WMATA Chief Safety Officer, and the General Manager in accordance with Section 2.C.
