The review completed by the WMSC shows that the Quality Assurance (QA) certifiers were not verifying the MSRPH requirement as required. The rail operation audit finding #13 uncovered that Metrorail has not printed or distributed current version of the Metrorail Safety Rules and Procedures Handbook (MSRPH). In addition, the required precertification training records were missing form all files reviewed. All defects identified were discussed with Metrorail at the conclusion of the records review.						s
