



The location of the inspection was the Carmen Tuner Training Facility - (CTF). METHOD: Five random Student Train Operator files were selected from the following two Student Train Operators class files provided to the WMSC Inspectors by Metrorail ROQT management: 1.) TO-23-01. 2.) TO-22-01. The random Student Train Operator files were reviewed to confirm the fact that Student Train Operators were meeting the requirements of thirty eight hours of OJT during the YPT and eight hours of supervised operating instruction by Line Platform Instructors - (LPI) on Metrorail mainline. The sampling of class files were reviewed for discrepancies and/or inconsistencies.


