

THE WASHINGTON METRORAIL SAFETY COMMISSION

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE WMSC DRAFT FY 2025 WORK PROGRAM AND BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Washington Metrorail Safety Commission (“WMSC”) is the state safety oversight agency for the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority rail system and was created for the benefit of the people of the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Virginia, and the State of Maryland (collectively, “the Signatories”);

WHEREAS, the WMSC entered into a Master Agreement dated June 15, 2019, with the Signatories to govern the process for establishing an annual work program (“SSOA WP”) and budget in order for the WMSC to fulfill its state safety oversight responsibilities as required under 49 U.S.C. § 5329;

WHEREAS, the Master Agreement requires that the Board of Directors (“Board”), by November 1 each year, approve a draft of the SSOA WP and budget before it is submitted to the Signatories for review and comment; and

WHEREAS, the Draft Fiscal Year 2025 SSOA WP and Budget is now before the Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE WASHINGTON METRORAIL SAFETY COMMISSION:

Approves the attached Draft Fiscal Year 2025 SSOA WP and Budget.
