The inspection involved the closed Corrective Action Plan - CO040. The following information is a specific description of the required actions of the CAP: 1. Metrorail was prescribed to develop a formal procedure for the training and demonstration of all Rodway Worker Protection (RWP) Safety Equipment and Warning Devices. 2. The completed procedure must include a standardized checklist for Instructors to follow during the practical demonstration, including a requisite that each student physically demonstrates the ability and understanding to use each device or other piece of equipment. The risk level of CO040 is rated at 2C -Undesirable Management Decision. METHOD: The Inspection was performed by two WMSC Inspectors and took place by observing a New Train Operator class. It is important to note that the participants in the class included Metrorail Bus Operators that typically have no rail experience. The Lack of rail experience introduces the need for clear understanding of RWP related Safety equipment such as Shunts, Wayside Strobe Alarm Device (WSAD) and Hot sticks as well as how to properly use them when required for mitigation of the third rail electrical hazard. Components of the inspection comprised of the listed pars: - Questioning about the physical presence and use of a checklist -(Instructors were asked if checklists were being used and included in class folders upon completion. The result -3 out of 3 answered no. Zero instructors are using checklists are know longer being used by the relevant RWP classes. Therefore, 0 forms are available for the calendar year 2023.
