	Wednesday October 10, 2023, to remove the old rule books. The WMSC was again informed that the rule books were still present in the Carmen Tuner Training Facility. The fact that the outdated rule books had not been removed became the catalyst of this inspection. This situation is an ongoing challenge to Metrorail as it has not currently been resolved and violates the mandates of C-0193. The WMSC Inspectors observed training and testing with rulebooks dating back to 2011. The use of safety rulebooks from over a decade ago introduces risk of ambiguous understanding and propose of safety rules as they are applied in the field. METHOD: Two WMSC inspectors performed a random spot check of different departmental classrooms at CTF. The departments that were inspected were the Office of Rail Transportation (RTRA) and Technical Skills and Maintenance Training (TSMT). A total of 12 different classrooms were inspected. Each separate classroom was inspected for the presence of outdated rule books and evidence demonstrating whether the rule books are still being used during instruction
