Description	WMSC Conducted observations of ADO testing on the Green Line from Greenbelt to Branch Avenue Stations and back. Railcars L3162-63, 3238-39, 3189-88, 2055-54 were used. The following items were observed. Finding #1 - Track #2, Doors did not open at Greenbelt and College Park Stations, and there was a 5 second delay to get the speed commands to drop then the doors opened at Shaw Station. See Attached Photos #1 and #2. Finding #2 - Track #1, Doors did not open at L'Enfant, West Hyattsville, and College Park Stations. See Attached Photos #3 through #4. Track #1, There was a flashing console and lost speed commands between Waterfront and L'Enfant stations. ATC issue. Track #1, Near Southern Avenue Station, radio communication was out of range. The radio makes a humming sound when the radio is out of range. Known issue. After testing was completed, the VMS data was downloaded.								No	o
