

THE WASHINGTON METRORAIL SAFETY COMMISSION

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE WMSC DRAFT FISCAL YEAR 2026 WORK
PROGRAM AND BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Washington Metrorail Safety Commission (“WMSC”) is the state safety oversight authority for the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority rail system and was created for the benefit of the people of the District of Columbia, Commonwealth of Virginia, and State of Maryland (collectively, “the jurisdictions”);

WHEREAS, the WMSC entered into a Master Agreement dated June 15, 2019, with the jurisdictions to govern the process for establishing an annual work program (“SSOA WP”) and budget in order for the WMSC to fulfill its state safety oversight responsibilities as required under 49 U.S.C. § 5329;

WHEREAS, the Master Agreement requires that the Commissioners, by November 1 of each year, approve a draft of the SSOA WP and Budget before it is submitted to the jurisdictions for review and comments; and

WHEREAS, the Draft Fiscal Year 2026 SSOA WP and Budget is now before the Commissioners;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE WASHINGTON METRORAIL SAFETY COMMISSION:

Approves the proposed Draft Fiscal Year 2026 SSOA WP and Budget.
