Description	Mobile Command Roadway Safety Job Briefing (RJSB). The RSJB was completed correctly and in its entirety by the mobile command safety briefer. The inspection team observed additional briefings held by the mobile command and all were found to be following Roadway worker Protection (RWP) guidelines. One item requiring immediate attention was identified during the Forest Glen Station Walk through. A junction box located at the platform level between fan room 612 and the Area of Refuge room 608 had water coming through the box. Inside the box there are wires connected with wire nuts. The inspection team exited the station and notified Metrorail SAFE of the electrical hazard condition. Work order number 18698188 was created to correct the identified hazard.
