The following observations were noted Defect #1 - The main HVAC unit of the S&I shop that provides cooling to most of the enclosed office spaces was not operating. It was stated that the HVAC unit was out of service for two weeks. CMNT personnel requested that a priority be placed on these repairs due to the extreme hot weather conditions. CMNT personnel stated that repairs were expected to be completed by the end of the day, July 10, 2024. A follow-up conversation with CMNT personnel confirmed that the HVAC unit was repaired as stated Defect #2 - Railcar lifts alarms turn on every time railcars are lifted or lowered to notify personnel to stay clear of railcar movements. These alarms are also located in the basement next to the parts storeroom. These alarms sound louder when they go off near personnel that work in the storeroom. Check the feasibility of lowering the intensity of these alarms so that they do not cause harm to personnel that work in spaces near the alarms. See attached Photos #1 and #2.									o
